

School Uniform - (Dwarka)

SUMMER

Boys (Dwarka)

1. Shirt:

- a) Nursery to Class V - Checked half sleeved.
- b) Class VI upwards - Cream, half sleeved with school crest on pocket.
- c) Monday (Nursery - Class XII): White, half sleeved with school crest on pocket.

- d) House Activity Day/Friday (Class I upwards): House colour t-shirt.

2. Shorts/Pants:

- a) Nursery to Class VIII - Olive green shorts.
- b) Class IX upwards – Olive green regular pants, comfort fit (Low slung prohibited).
- c) Monday (Nursery to VIII): White shorts (Low slung prohibited).
- d) Class IX upwards - White pants, comfort fit. (Low slung prohibited)

- e) House Activity Day/Friday (Class I to VIII): House colour Shorts.

Girls (Dwarka)

1. Tunic/Shirt

- a) Nursery & Preparatory - checked tunic
- b) Nursery & Preparatory (Monday / Friday): White tunic
- c) Class I to Class V - Checked frock with box pleats.
- d) Class VI upwards - Cream half sleeved with school crest on pocket.
- e) Monday (Class I upwards): White half sleeved with school crest on pocket.

- f) House Activity Day/Friday (Class I upwards): House colour t-shirt.

2. Skirt

- a.) Above Class VI: Olive green with six box pleats, mid-knee length (Low slung and above knee prohibited).
- b) Monday & House Activity Day/Friday (Class I upwards): White mid knee length (White Divided skirts Class VI upwards)

i. Shoes & Socks:

- a) Shoes: Plain black leather shoes for everyday (preferably Oxford).

- b) White Sports shoes for Mondays & Fridays. (No coloured design on shoe)

- c) Socks: White with school stripes.

ii. Black school belt and House badge (Class I upwards).

iii. Patka: Olive green (for Sikhs). On House Activity Day: white
