### **CBSE RESULTS:**

#### **Class XII**

A total of 229 students appeared for the Senior Secondary Examination conducted by CBSE in April-May 2023. The best aggregate percentage scored by Kavya Singh (XII A) was 98.4% (aggregate of 5 subjects).

- 23 students secured 95% and above.
- 72 students secured 90% and above.
- 150 students secured 80% and above.

#### **CLASS X**

A total of 254 students appeared for Class X examination this year. The best aggregate percentage of was 98.40% secured by Raghav Dutta. 27 students scored above 95%, 86 students secured above 90% and 169 students scored above 80%.

4. Twelve of our students (Tamanna Tikoo, Gurubaanie Bhatnagar, Ipsita Singh, Mokshada Kulkarni, Govind Singh, Saamarth Silas Massey, Aditya Seth, Shaurya K Sharma, Kalbe Mustafa, Mikul Rai, Kavya Singh and Sara Akhtar got admitted in reputed Foreign Universities.

5. Eight students (Manasvi Singh, Esha Lall, Tamali Bandyopadhyay, Dhvani Mathur, Koushiki Mukherjee, Manisha Mehra, Gaurika Singh and Vanisha Kohli) got admission in medical colleges; five students (Dhriti Kaistha, Vaani Parashar, Aarushi Chauhan, Shervill Poonia and Amitoz Kaur) in various Law colleges; many others got admission in other reputed colleges.
